### **Directions to Port Whitby Marina**

#### **By Water**

Coordinates – Near Buoy 43°50'92"N, 78°55'62"W.

A set of red and green buoys mark the harbour entrance. The outer end of the eastern pier displays a lighthouse with a red flashing light. The outer end of the western pier displays a green flashing light.

Inside the harbour, follow the buoyed channel to the Marina (north east corner).

#### By Land

Address – 301 Watson Street West, Whitby, ON

Use Exit 410 (Brock Street Whitby) from Highway 401. Head south on Brock Street past Victoria Street, turn right onto Watson Street West, and past Charles Street; the Port Whitby Marina entrance will be on the left or south side of Watson Street West.
