## Improving Resident Access to Care Close to Home

The Town of Whitby, in line with its Community Strategic Plan, is focused on bringing care closer to home for residents. In October 2024, Whitby celebrated the opening of the Whitby Health Centre in West Whitby, which will serve as a hub for 85 physicians, including specialists. Residents needing a family physician can join the waiting list at oshawaclinic.com. For urgent care, the centre's clinic is open daily—visit the Oshawa Clinic Group's website for hours. Last year, Durham residents shared their stories about the importance of a new hospital in Whitby, resulting in the provincial announcement of a planning grant for Lakeridge Health. To encourage more housing in Whitby, the Town offers financial incentives for property owners adding legal basement apartments (additional dwelling units), covering fees for building permits and registrations. # **Whitby Winter**



For effective snow removal, overnight on-street parking is not permitted.

Monday, February 3, marks the halfway point between the Winter Solstice and the Spring Equinox. Whether you love winter or eagerly await warmer weather, the Town is dedicated to keeping our community safe for winter travel through sanding, salting, and snow removal. Here's how to navigate the rest of winter:

## **Keeping You Safe And Moving**

Whitby's winter operations team needs your help to keep the community safe and traffic moving this winter. You can help make a difference by:

- Moving basketball and hockey nets off the road
- Clearing snow and ice from sidewalks within 24 hours of a snowfall
- · Keeping fire hydrants clear of snow

A reminder that overnight on-street parking is not permitted on roads now through April 15. The annual seasonal restriction is in place so snowplow operators can clear away ice and snow quickly and easily during the hours when there is less traffic and impact on drivers.
